
Technical specifications

Margin recommendations mainly apply to printed publications. We still specify them for your information.

The most important rule is that it is necessary to draw on the largest possible page surface to make sure you don't lack material after page trim, and include the key elements in the "C" area.

The printing area and margins may vary depending on the manga's format. Sometimes a drawing which only extends to the "B" area may not be large enough, resulting in a white frame between the drawing and the border of the page.

A drawing which extends to the "A" area can be adapted to various formats. However, please make sure you don't include important elements or text there, as they could be trimmed during printing.
